Introduction

This document provides step-by-step instructions for installing the SLS™ MA480AS or MA460AS 3-Axis Speaker System. These speaker systems were developed to reduce the time and expense required when installing speakers in Dolby Atmos® cinema environments.

THIS EQUIPMENT MUST BE INSTALLED BY LICENSED PROFESSIONAL INSTALLERS.

1.1 Tools Required

To install the MA480AS or the MA460AS, you need the following tools (in addition to the tools required to attach the user-supplied suspension hardware to the structure):

- M8 Allen wrench for main yoke attachment point (M10 bolt)
- Phillips screwdriver for barrier strip speaker wire inputs

1.2 Spare Parts

You should replace any defective components with SLS approved parts. Contact the factory directly at 417-883-4549 to obtain approved replacement parts. SLS is not responsible for problems caused by using parts not provided by SLS for the SLS supplied portion of the rigging.

1.3 Specifications

Installing the MA480AS and the MA460AS

This chapter is provided for licensed professional installers. The following sections include step-by-step instructions for installing the SLS™ MA480AS or MA460AS 3-Axis Speaker Systems.

2.1 Installing the System

Following are the installation instructions.

2.1.1 Identifying the Rigging Parts

The following parts are included in the packing kit. Use these parts along with your desired mounting method (typically, all thread mounted to structure). The MA480AS and MA460AS ship with the yoke installed, but the speaker body is not shown for clarity:

- 1. Two 20 mm steel washers
- 2. Two 20 mm neoprene washers
- One yoke with slot for angle adjustments (while user-supplied captive bolts are still loose)

A safety cable and zip ties are also required, but are not included in this kit. These parts must be provided by the installer. (See Section 2.1.4.)




Figure 2-1 Rigging Assembly

2.1.2 Positioning

The MA460AS and MA480AS provide 3-axis aiming adjustments when using a single mount point to the structure. To properly aim the speaker, you must correctly position the horn. Each of the three axis adjustment angles (D,C, and G) are identified with the same letter as they are by the angle requirements in the Dolby Atmos® Room Design Tool spreadsheet (applicable for both overhead and sidewall positions). The Dolby Atmos Room Design Tool is an Excel-based tool that is used to help design a room and plan equipment to ensure that the design meets Dolby requirements. The following figure shows the MA460AS and MA480AS coverage angles.




Figure 2-2 Sound Dispersion Views (Shown Without Grille)

The provided yoke attachment to the speaker pivot point is labeled **Angle D**. The parting line in the speaker enclosure is the angle indicator.

The slot in the yoke sliding adjustment is labeled **Angle C**. The following figure is an example of a single point to structure rigging setup used with the **Angle C** yoke sticker to indicate the desired degree. The center of the user-provided suspension point is used as a reference to set the angle.

The single point attachment to the structure pivot point is labeled **Angle G** (contained in the packing kit). The following figure is an example of using a single rigging point for suspension. This provided angle sticker needs to be adhered to a ceiling tile in the correct orientation as marked on the sticker (the arrow pointing to screen direction). The side of the yoke is used as the angle indicator.




Figure 2-5 Angle G at 0 and 45 Degrees

To position the unit:

- 1. Position and tighten the yoke for **Angle C** and **Angle G** with the loudspeaker removed from the yoke.
- 2. Reinstall the loudspeaker in the yoke.
- 3. Adjust **Angle D** (using the parting line on the loudspeaker enclosure as the aiming point relative to the provided sticker), and then tighten the M10 bolts to set **Angle D**.



Note: The provided aiming sticker for **Angle G** is not calibrated for use with the WMA-15 wall mount kit. An inclinometer placed on the side of the yoke can provide the information needed for **Angle G** when installing on a side wall.

To help with aiming adjustments and to verify that the loudspeaker is not installed upside down, you can also use the grille shape. The furthest extruding formed edge of the grille is parallel with the top edge of the asymmetrical horn. As a result, aligning this formed grille edge with the seating rake for side wall positions and the seating rows for overhead positions, properly orientates the loudspeaker in this axis to the coverage area. This same formed grille edge must always be closest to the ceiling, whether in a side wall or overhead position. This ensures that the horn is not flipped upside down.




Figure 2-6 Verify Axis Orientation

2.1.3 Connecting Audio

To connect audio, connect your speaker wire to the yoke without making contact with the speaker enclosure (to minimize any buzzing). The barrier strips accept 16 to 12 gauge wire, either with spade lugs or bare wire.


2.1.4 Connecting the Safety Cable

You must connect a safety cable (not included) as follows:

- Use the safety cable to independently connect the speaker to the building structure.
 An M6 eyebolt (not shown) that is attached to the speaker input plate is provided for this purpose.
- 2. Pull the safety cable snugly against the M6 eyebolt, and secure the safety cable to the yoke using zip ties (not provided) to minimize the possibility of buzzing against the cabinet or the eyebolt.
